Why Would Jesus Have to Obey His Parents?

Ephesians 6:1-3 Children, obey your parents because you belong to the Lord, for this is the right thing to do. "Honor your father and mother." This is the first commandment with a promise: If you honor your father and mother, "things will go well for you, and you will have a long life on the earth." (NLT)

God's Promises To Obedient Children...

- 1. That it may go well with you (Great things)
- 2. That you may live long in the land (Long life)

Because we belong to the Lord Jesus, it is right to obey and honor our parents as Jesus did.

- 1. Kids
 - Right away, all the way, in a cheerful way

2. Teens

- Honor your parents by remembering their instruction and imitating their example.
- Be Open and honest and ask them for advice.

3. Adults

- You honor your parents by taking care of them as they get older.
- You honor your parents as you trust and obey Jesus Christ.
