John 8:1-11 But Jesus went to the Mount of Olives. ² Early in the morning He came again to the temple. All the people came to Him, and He sat down and taught them. ³ The scribes and the Pharisees brought a woman who had been caught in adultery, and placing her in the midst ⁴ they said to Him, "Teacher, this woman has been caught in the act of adultery. ⁵ Now in the Law, Moses commanded us to stone such women. So what do You say?" ⁶ This they said to test Him, that they might have some charge to bring against Him. Jesus bent down and wrote with His finger on the ground. ⁷ And as they continued to ask Him, He stood up and said to them, "Let him who is without sin among you be the first to throw a stone at her." ⁸ And once more He bent down and wrote on the ground. ⁹ But when they heard it, they went away one by one, beginning with the older ones, and Jesus was left alone with the woman standing before Him. ¹⁰ Jesus stood up and said to her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?" ¹¹ She said, "No one, Lord." And Jesus said, "Neither do I condemn you; go, and from now on sin no more." ESV

Jesus' response to the adulterous woman teaches us that...

Self-Righteousness keeps people at a distance.

John 8:7 And as they continued to ask Him, He stood up and said to them, "Let him who is without sin among you be the first to throw a stone at her." ESV

Holiness is the standard for casting judgment.

John 8:8-9 And once more He bent down and wrote on the ground. ⁹ But when they heard it, they went away one by one, beginning with the older ones, and Jesus was left alone with the woman standing before Him. ESV

Holiness blended with love is the right response.

John 8:10-11 Jesus stood up and said to her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?" ¹¹ She said, "No one, Lord." And Jesus said, "Neither do I condemn you; go, and from now on sin no more." ESV

How can Christ Followers blend holiness and love?

•	Remember that we are sinners saved by grace.
	Ephesians 2:8–9 For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, ⁹ not a result of works, so that no one may boast. ESV
•	Guard our hearts from harmful ideas.
	Proverbs 4:23 Above all else, guard your heart, for it is the wellspring of life. NIV1984
•	We love sacrificially.
	Ephesians 5:1–2 Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. ² And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave Himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God. ESV
	"Agape" (love) - Acts in the best interest of someone before God
•	We refuse to add on to holiness with opinions.
	Romans 14:1 As for the one who is weak in faith, welcome him, but not to quarrel over opinions. ESV
